Reminders



Please do not use the school car park. this is reserved for staff, school taxis and Blue Badge holders only. If you have a Blue Badge, please display clearly. Children are coming to school with large back packs. We are still not using the cloakrooms fully and therefore coats and bags are having to be stored in classrooms or corridors. Family Lateral Flow Testing (LFT)

On the Parent feedback forms I introduced last week, some of you asked about how LFTs could be accessed for families. From 1 March 2021, if you are a member of a household, childcare bubble or support bubble of staff or a pupil, you can get a twice-weekly test; there are a number of ways in which you can do this:

You can take a rapid lateral flow test at a local site

Testing at these sites is assisted, which means you will swab yourself under the supervision of a trained operator.

You may need to book an appointment Find your nearest rapid lateral flow test site (click)

You can collect test kits from a local collection point

You can collect 2 packs of home test kits at a local collection point. Each pack contains 7 tests. Anyone 18 or over can collect. You can check online if the location is busy before you go.

Find your nearest home test kit collection point. (click)

You can order home test kits online

If you cannot get tested at your workplace, or are unable to go to a test site or collect test kits, you can order a home test kit online.

Do not order online if you can get a test through other methods. This frees up home delivery for those who need it most. Order rapid lateral flow home test kits (click)
