- Parents would like to be more informed about what their child is learning in maths and be able to support them more at home through homework tasks. From September we will post the termly maths plans for each year group on the website in the maths section, so parents can see what is being covered. If you would like to do further work at home we recommend the CGP workbooks which are available cheaply online for each year group.
- Polling station: I have written to the election officer at the council and have asked him to explain why potential venues suggested by parents cannot be used as an alternative polling station. I have been told that the use of schools as polling stations was reviewed last Autumn. I will let you know as soon as I get a response.
