Please read the points below to enable you to make the most of what our website has to offer:

- Whilst the site is best viewed on a computer screen or tablet, you can view it on your phone please be patient and allow it some time to load up the first time. I have found that once you have done this, it is there immediately thereafter.
- Class pages: we wanted to include the class pages on the main website rather than on the old style VLE. Not only does this enable the world to see what fantastic work the classes are doing, it allows you and your children to access the pages quickly and without the need for a password. Please make a habit of visiting your class page frequently, as they will be regularly updated with news and photos. (remember, if you don't want your child's photograph to appear on the main site, just let me know.)
- A link to the most recent 'School News' can be found at the bottom of the home page. Past editions of the newsletter, dating back to January 2014, can be found under the 'School Information' menu.
- The calendar will be kept up to date so please use it as your first point of reference for events taking place in school. If you click on an event on the calendar it will take you to more detailed information such as timings.
- You can see our latest 'tweet' on the homepage but remember to sign up to Twitter and follow us @EtchellsPS for day to day information, photos and reminders.
- At present the children DO NOT have log-ins. This will be our next step in the redesign of the website and we will let you know when this area is ready to access. Because so much of our school information is on the main site, the log-in will simply enable children to engage with homework tasks, communicate through blogs and to participate in forums to further their learning. These aspects of using computers are fast becoming life skills and we will be ensuring children of all ages develop a secure understanding of e-safety.
