
Spelling | Safer Internet Day | Mobile Phones

Mobile Phones



It has come to our attention that children are bringing mobile phones into school and using them secretly at break times to take photos which are then uploaded. Mobile phones are NOT allowed in school apart

from special circumstances. All of Year 6 were sent a copy of our mobile phone policy yesterday and a consent form if needed. We appreciate that some children may need a phone for safety reasons for their journey to and from school if they are unaccompanied. If this is the case, a consent form must be completed and returned to school. Phones must be handed into the office before registration and collected at 3.15pm.

Spelling

We have been discussing as a staff the importance of spelling and the emphasis that is placed on it with the New National Curriculum. If the children can't spell ALL the words for their year group in their books or tests, they will not meet the Age Related Expectation for writing. This is a really tough ask and in years gone by we have been able to apply a 'best fit' assessment to writing, making allowances for occasional spelling mistakes if the writing is of good quality.

The position now is that it if a child's writing is of an excellent standard, but includes mis-spelt words, they will not meet expectation. After half term, we will be sending home mid-term reports in advance of Parents' Evening taking place the week after. The teachers will indicate if spelling is a concern with your child's writing and will ask for you to support the learning of these words at home.

If you don't have them already, word lists are available on our website, from the internet or from your child's class teacher.
