Behaviour in School

The staff and I are becoming increasingly concerned with behaviour through school. We have spent several staff meetings discussing the policy and the courses of action to take when school rules are not followed. We have also devised a working party of Year 5 and 6 children who have been talking to me about what they would like to see in place regarding discipline.

The new ladder of consequences has been formulated and instead of waiting until September to implement, we have decided to bring in the new procedures on Monday. The main changes relate to KS2: children will be given 3 verbal warnings when not following rules, followed by a time out in the class which will be recorded in a behaviour book. This can then be communicated to you at Parents Evenings. Following time out, a 15 minute lunchtime dentition will be served (this was requested by the children); this will be recorded in the homework diary so you are aware of sanctions carried out at home. Repeated detentions will result in a phone call home from myself to parents to discuss further actions.

When the Governors have reviewed the policy, we will put it on the website in order for you to read the full detail. I will inform you when this happens. We hope these procedures will form tighter guidance for both teachers and pupils and fully inform parents about the behaviour of their child.
