Please continue to use the designated entrances and bear in mind that children can be dropped off anytime between 8.45am and 8.55am. We have had a number of children this week arriving after 9am; after this time, the gates will be locked and a late mark put in the register. Please ensure your child is in school by 8.55am.

At pick up time, please only wait in the playground if you need to pick up siblings. We ask that everyone respects one another's safety by keeping your distance. Face coverings must continue to be worn; this is a direction from the Local Authority.
