September Arrangements

Guidance for Educational Settings has been changed for September. The children will no longer be restricted to bubbles. However, we will do our best to keep them in their year groups as much as possible in order to reduce the spread of any infections. As a school, we will no longer be carrying out Track and Trace procedures or asking whole classes or year groups to isolate. Track and Tracing will be carried out by the NHS. If you do find that your child tests positive however, please let me know immediately and keep them away from school for the isolation period. If we have several positive cases at the same time, procedures may well have to be reviewed.

We are keeping drop off and pick up times the same for now: 8.45 - 8.55am drop off for all and 3.05pm pick up for EYFS/KS1, 3.15pm for KS2. Please continue to use the same entry and exit points, sticking to the one way system and respecting everyone's personal space.

We will be keeping key phases together for playtimes, and year groups will access the hall for lunch and the outdoor areas with their own dedicated Mid-Day Assistant.

In September, we will give you more information regarding clubs which we hope to get up and running more widely for the Autumn term. The Breakfast and After school club, "Little Flyers" is now taking bookings for wrap-around care.

Please be reminded that all children will be required to wear black leggings/joggers and a white T-shirt on PE days with their school sweatshirt.
