It has been brought to our attention by the Local Authority that Stockport and other areas of Greater Manchester are experiencing increased levels of Measles. There are concerns that a number of children have not received their MMR vaccine. It is important to remember that Measles can be a serious disease and in the most severe cases can lead to liver infection, eye damage and meningitis. This year the PTA are fundraising to help fund a brand new wooden trim trail to replace our rather old decaying one! We have grand plans for a really long challenging trail with new safe ground surfacing. The idea is to encourage physical activity at playtimes and lunchtime and to give opportunities for our pupils to be as active as possible. We will make up the rest from our school budget. It is a very exciting project and so we're extremely grateful to everyone who supports the PTA to enable this to happen. We are hoping installation will take place during the Whit Half Term.
