We have asked on many occasions for an alternative location to be found but it has not been possible. For the safeguarding of our children, we will not be able to open.

Building Work and Grounds Improvements

You will have noticed that over the summer we have begun work replacing the roof of the main school building. Completion is not expected until mid October, but be reassured that all safety measures, risk assessments and DBS checks are in place. The roofers are working over the weekends too in order to get the job completed as quickly as possible. The roof improvement works created an enormous amount of dust and debris in the main school corridor and I would like to extend my thanks to the huge effort from the staff team on Monday to get the building ship-shape and ready for the children on Wednesday.

Earlier this week we had a volunteer team in from SKY to help us with jobs around the school grounds. This included

painting tyres for a future tyre art project due to go near Nursery entrance; digging out the field footpath and installing new membrane, edging and wood chip; finishing off painting the railings at the front of school.







Our thanks also to Mr Gilham for his work tidying up the bushes and greenery and helping our outdoor area look smart once again.

Our local B&Q generously donated sensory plants, herbs, bulbs, seeds and compost. Staff have planted up the Reception and Nursery Planters and children will plant bulbs and grow seeds during Forest School sessions.

The time and donations from local businesses and volunteers are really appreciated and make all the difference to our school environment, so our thanks to all involved.
