Attendance!!

As you are aware, attendance is a serious issue that we are working on to improve in our school. Last year the percentage of children attending school rose from 94.2% to 95.9%. This was a very pleasing rise and exceeded our target of 95.5%. However, last year's national average attendance figures have just been announced as being 96.1%. This means that we are still below the National Average which will have a negative impact on the behaviour and safety aspect of our next Ofsted inspection. More importantly, it is indicating the large number of children who are missing school and therefore not making the progress they should be.

Our new ambitious target for attendance is set at 97%. If we are to provide the best opportunities for our children, they need to be in school! We need to have the highest expectations.

New rewards for attendance:

We are no longer rewarding 100% of attendance. Whilst this may seem strange, I feel strongly that for many children, a 2 day absence due to sickness cannot be avoided. We have found that children do not want to be off school when they actually really need to be at home - they are disappointed to miss out on their 100% attendance badge. So instead, each term, we will be giving certificates for 'Outstanding Attendance' - those children who have 98% and above.

Each half term we will generate the attendance percentage for each class and reward the highest class with a non-uniform day. This began today with class 5L who had the top attendance figure for this half term of 98.2%. Well done!! I have included a table on the left of each class in school. Please take note if your class needs improving and do your bit! Every half term we will start again so it's not too late to make a difference.

At Parents Evening, you will receive an attendance report for your child. Attendance meeting our target of 97% will be highlighted green, those under target will be highlighted yellow and those causing extreme concern will be pink. Please look at this report carefully.

Parents' Evenings


