#### **Attendance**

As you are all aware, attendance for our school is a significant cause for concern. We remain below the National Average for our overall percentage for attendance. Absence has been shown to have a significant effect on the progress and achievement of pupils and so it is vital we keep days off school to an absolute minimum. We have had a disappointing start to the year with many families returning late from holidays. This year we will be taking a much stricter stance on authorising leave which is in line with some of our neighbouring schools. Trips abroad to attend weddings will no longer be authorised and we will continue to unauthorise any holidays during term time. Fines will be issued to families who take unauthorised absence. In addition to this. children who are off for a number of single days in a term will also be subject to fines, as will children who are persistently late.

Our EWO (Education Welfare Officer) comes into school on a monthly basis to monitor attendance and where necessary, will refer to the LA for fines.
