## **Return to School Arrangements**

- Dropping off: we are really pleased with how dropping off has improved throughout the week. The children are able to enter school without waiting or congestion. Some parents, however, are dropping their children off very early and sending them into school. There may not be a teacher in the classroom to supervise them so we ask that drop off times are adhered to.
- Picking up: we have had a number of children this week who have been picked up extremely late. Due to our bubble arrangements, children cannot be brought to the office to wait and teachers are not available to supervise children after 3.15pm. It is vitally important, for the safety of everyone, that children are picked up on time.
- Bags in School: some children are coming to school with very large rucksacks. This is not allowed. Cloakrooms are currently out of use and space is extremely limited in classrooms. The only items your child should be bringing to school are a water bottle, reading book and if needed, a lunch box. These should be brought in a small bag
- **Important: School Lunches:** we have found it impossible to get Years 1 to 6 through the hall in separate year groups to eat a hot dinner in 90 minutes. Next week Reception will be having their hot dinners too. We are dedicated to keeping to our bubble arrangements and so cannot mix year groups in the hall. Therefore, from Monday 21st September, KS2 (years 3-6), will have a cold grab bag provided for their school lunch. It will be brought to the classroom by the bubble Mid Day Assistant and the whole class will eat their lunches together. This will allow more time for Reception, Year 1 and 2 to eat their dinners in the hall. The grab bags will typically contain a sandwich, pudding, piece of fruit and a drink. If you would rather provide a packed lunch, please let the school office know by the end of the day on Monday (14th). It's worth noting that some local schools are providing cold grab bags only, but we felt strongly that we wanted to continue to provide hot lunches for EYFS and KS1. My thanks to Dawn Unwin in the kitchen for agreeing to this arrangement.
