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Parent Council

Disco Time!!

You should have received your letter regarding the school disco earlier this week. If you would like tickets, please ensure you have returned the slip by next Wednesday. As you are aware, we are rigorous in our safeguarding procedures and photographs being taken. For this reason, we ask that mobile phones are <u>not</u> brought to the discos by children.

The younger children will be taken to the hall by their teachers and KS2 can arrive through the front door. We would like ALL parents to collect from the hall using the first playground door to enter and and the main playground door to leave. Children will not be able to leave without an adult with them.



Late Pick Ups

We are continuing to have an ongoing problem with children being picked up late from school. School finishes at 3.15pm and children need to be picked up at this time. As the After School Club is now run by an outside provider, we can no longer ask for children who have not been picked up to be supervised there.

Therefore, any pupil who has not been picked up in a reasonable time will come to my office to await collection. They will then need signing out, using the late collection book, just as we do with late arrivals in the morning.

Children who are repeatedly picked up late from after school clubs, will not be able to sign up for the following term.

Many of you already allow plenty of time for your journeys and to park in order to avoid lateness. We would like to ask this of ALL parents to alleviate this problem. Thank you.
