## **Isolation Rules**

Unfortunately, we have one of our year groups self-isolating at the moment. It has been brought to my attention, that children within this

group have been seen outside, in the park, on the school playground and in the village. Anybody self-isolating must not leave the house. This doesn't apply to parents or other family members however. Please see the guidance set out by the NHS below. It is a huge sacrifice to have to stay at home and miss precious days education in school. Therefore, I ask for these rules to be followed properly.

### How to self-isolate

You must not leave your home if you're self-isolating.

#### Don't

- ★ do not go to work, school or public places work from home if you can
- X do not go on public transport or use taxis
- do not go out to get food and medicine order it online or by phone, or ask someone to bring it to your home
- do not have visitors in your home, including friends and family – except for people providing essential care
- do not go out to exercise exercise at home or in your garden, if you have one
