The half termly non-uniform prize for the class with the highest attendance goes to RG who have a combined percentage of 95.5%. We will be awarding all children who have attendance at 98% or above with a merit - this will be done after half term. You will receive a copy of your child's attendance record with the mid-term report before parents' evening.

Our current school attendance at the half way point of this academic year lies at 95.3%, below national average. We are aiming to be above the national average of 96% by the end of the year. It would be a fantastic achievement if we could achieve this by all working together and keeping family holidays within the school holidays.
