## **Parents' Maths Information Session**

On Wednesday next week (23rd March) at 3.30pm we will be holding an information session for parents around Maths. This has been requested by many parents and we hope you will be able to attend. During the session we will be explaining the requirements of the New National Curriculum, as well as demonstrating our calculation policy. Many parents have asked for clarification about the way we teach various methods for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. The teachers in turn will demonstrate the progression in each of these areas and show you how the calculations are set out and recorded. There will be handouts for you to take away with useful apps and websites and you will also be able to take away the age related expectations for maths related to any year group you choose.

**IMPORTANT**: If you are intending to come to the session please return the slip sent home yesterday to school. We need this back by Monday morning at the latest in order for us to prepare the correct amount of handouts.

#### Games and PE kits

It has been brought to my attention that many of the KS2 boys are wearing full football kits for games and PE.
