



Year 4 Trip to Styal

Year 4 learnt so much during their trip to Quarry Bank Mill in Styal. They used a map with coordinates and a compass to find their way around the grounds. To learn about how a river meanders, they threw biscuits over a bridge and investigated whether the wider part of the river was faster. Some children threw apples in the river while others measured the speed at which the river was flowing. They also went in a shallow tributary with nets to find out if anything lived in the river. A fantastic example of bringing our learning to life and having fun!
