Please take note.....

- If your child has had a bout of sickness or diarrhoea, they must not return to school for 48 hours after the last occurrence. This is standard procedure for schools and is in place to prevent the spread of these contagious illnesses.
- Please make a regular habit of checking your child for head lice. Unfortunately it is a common and frequently occurring issue in school and must be treated immediately. I would like to stress however, that a full day's absence should not be taken to treat head lice and will not be authorised.
- Parents are allowing their children to play on the climbing frame in the Early Years playground before and after school. This is not permitted as the supervision we normally have for this equipment is not in place at these times.
- We have attached to this email a Privacy Notice regarding our data protection procedures. Please read it and keep for your reference.

Last year we were lucky enough to plant willows in our school grounds to create tunnels, a dome and a fence. The children have really enjoyed using these in their outdoor learning and Forest School sessions.
