Coats!!

Now the weather is turning colder, please ensure your child comes to school with a coat. Some of the children have been outside for the lunchtime period without a coat and have been feeling the cold. Coats need to be waterproof and clearly named.



Red and Yellow Cards

Since the beginning of term, we have introduced a new behaviour system at lunchtime. We trialled a few ideas in the summer as we wanted to give the Mid Day Assistants a discipline system that was separate to the classroom.

This is how it works:



A yellow card is given for anyone breaking the rules. This includes fighting, disrespect and swearing. Five minutes time out is given on the side of the playground or field to

allow any situation to defuse and give time for reflection.



A red card is given for a second yellow card or instantly for a serious offence. On these occasions, the child is sent inside to spend the rest of their

lunchtime with Mrs Mallinson, Mr Malone or Mrs Beddows. The red card is recorded in the detention log. Each day is a fresh start.

Lining up

At the end of morning break, the whistle is blown and the children are able to stand in perfect silence as they come into school. This helps with the transition between play and learning and prepares the children for going back into school. However, at lunchtime, the children seem to find this much more difficult when they are lining up for the Mid Day Assistants. Therefore, children talking in line are sent to my office and on a second offence, given a red card. Unfortunately we have a number of children who are repeatedly talking and therefore missing lunchtimes. Parents of these pupils will be informed about this at Parents' Evening next week.

We are aiming for impeccable behaviour here at Etchells and our new rules and consistent approach is definitely helping us to achieve this aim. Our new behaviour policy will be made available to parents in the coming weeks.

Match Funding
