An urgent message will also be placed on the home page of the website. Please do not phone the school office to enquire about school closure: if you have not heard from us, then school is open as normal.

If other local schools are open or closed, please don't think that Etchells will be the same. The decision to close comes down to the safety of the school site and the availability of staff. Both of these factors can be very different for each school setting.

A final note on snow....if it snows, we aim to get outside and enjoy it! Please make sure your child comes to school with wellies, a pair of indoor shoes, ideally a change of socks (!), hats, gloves and a warm coat. All these items need to be NAMED!
