Did you know.....?



Some parents have been asking about the way children deal with difficult situations on the playground. In Key Stage 1, we ask the children to communicate their feelings and not to fight back or retaliate. We ask children to show a stop signal with their hand and tell others that they are not happy with the situation and to walk away. The Year 1 and 2 pupils are very clear about this and so we would appreciate it if parents could reinforce this strategy at home and re-iterate that this is the right thing to do.

Ramadan

Ramadan will be starting next month. In the past some parents have requested that their child participates in fasting while at school. We have previously consulted with the Governing Body and it was agreed that only children in Year 5 and 6 would be allowed to fast during the school day. A letter will be sent home for you to give permission should you wish your child to participate. Can I point out that during this period we will be holding SATs assessments, Freddie Fit Playground leader training for Y5 and Sports Day. Staying hydrated is important for these events so we ask you to consider your decision carefully.
