Welcome back to your child's last term at Etchells

This term, our topical investigation will be —"<u>Can you</u> <u>solve our Mesoamerican Mystery?</u> The children are going to be History Mystery investigators and are going to look at the mystery of the Mayan people. English Reading and SPaG

We will be preparing for the SATs Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (GPS) Test with daily revision along with daily reading VIPERS to support our preparation for our reading assessment.

<u>Maths</u>

In Maths, we will be continuing to ready ourselves for the SATs, we will be revising all mathematical skills prior to our SATs assessments in May. We will then have a focus on practical maths skills, such as the use of spreadsheets and creating house-hold budgets.

Science:

Our Science topics for the summer term are: The human circulatory system and Living things and their habitat. In the circulatory system we will be looking at how the heart works and the effects exercise has on the body. In living things and their habitats, the children will be learning about the Linnaean Classification system.

PSHE:

In RSE we will be learning about changes to our bodies, sex as part of a healthy relationships, human reproduction - from conception to birth. We will also look at how to keep our bodies safe, including hygiene and consensual physical contact. We will explore the role of the LGBTQ community, including the human rights and the history of LGBTQ campaigners. All resources can be viewed be arrangement with your child's class
