Holiday Fines

Important changes are being made to holiday fines - otherwise known as Education Penalty Notices (EPNs). The aim of the new rules is to reduce the number of days missed by children due to unauthorised absences - especially for term time holidays. They will take effect from September 2024 so please be mindful of the following points going forward:

- For the <u>first</u> fine issued for after the start of the 24-25 school year, the fine will increase to £80 per parent per child if paid within 21 days, or £160 if paid within 28 days.
- If a <u>second</u> fine is then issued to the same parent for the same child within three years of the first fine, it will be for £160.
- Subsequent offences no further fines can then be issued if two have already been issued to the same parent for the same child within the previous three years (starting with the date of the first fine); instead the parent will be prosecuted by the Local Authority in the Magistrates' Court.
