Year 2 and Year 6 will contain information regarding the outcomes of the SATs assessments as well as information comparing the performance of our school to others nationally. Year I parents will be notified whether their child met the expected standard in the phonics screening.

The reports inform all year groups about the progress made from either the end of Reception or the end of KSI and you will find out whether your child has met/ not met/ exceeded the end of year expectations for their year group.

You will also find that the teacher comment on the back page is much more focussed around the school's Core Values rather than recapping on curriculum coverage. We hope this gives parents a better picture of their children as learners, their attitudes and independence. Our Core Values are:
