Travel Tracker

To encourage healthy lifestyles and to try and improve the local environment around school, we are starting a new scheme called Travel Tracker. Each day the children will complete an electronic log on how they travelled to school. If they use an active method of transport at least once a week for a month they will receive a badge. There will be a new badge each month to collect.

We are aware some families live a distance from school and that walking, cycling etc, is not a realistic option. These children will be encouraged to 'park and stride.' This is where the car is parked at a distance that requires a

five minute walk to reach school. We hope that by making small changes it can have a big impact.
