## Padel Project

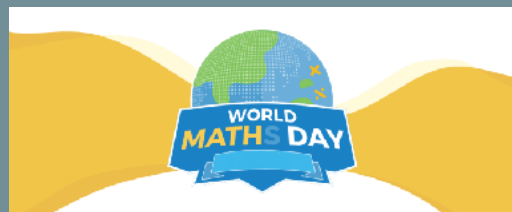
