Welcome back to your child's last term at Etchells

This term, our topical investigation will be —"Can you solve our Mesoamerican Mystery? The children are going to be History Mystery investigators and are going to look at the mystery of the Mayan people. They are going to look at their culture and lifestyle as well as possible reasons for their sudden and unexpected disappearance. We will also

English writing

English Reading and SPaG

We will be preparing for the SATs Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (GPS) Test with daily revision along with daily reading VIPERS to support our preparation for our reading assessment.

Maths

In Maths, we will be continuing to ready ourselves for the SATs, we will be revising all mathematical skills prior to our SATs assessments in May. We will then have a focus on practical maths skills, such as the use of spreadsheets and creating household budgets.

Science:

Our Science topics for the summer term are: The human circulatory system and Living things and their habitats. In the circulatory system we will be looking at how the heart works and the effects exerciser on the body. In living things and their habitat the children will be learning about the Linnaean Classification system.

PSHE:

This term we will be learning about RSE, including changes to our bodies, sex as part of a healthy relationships, human reproduction - from conception to birth.

Children will participle in reading sessions throughout the week, including comprehension, whole class and independent reading. In addition to this, it is a school expectation that children read to an adult, at home, at least three times a week.
