## **Christmas Arrangements**

Here is an outline of what is happening between now and the end of term:

#### Monday 13th

We would of course have liked to offer Christmas dinner to everyone, but we need to continue to be extremely mindful of health and safety and mitigate the risks of COVID spreading amongst our pupils and staff, especially just before Christmas. Everyone can wear their Christmas jumper or an own choice alternative on this day.

This will be our last day at school as we will be enjoying the Queen's Jubilee Bank Holiday on the 22nd! We will end the term with our traditional Christmas sing-a-long in the afternoon, connecting the classes via Google Meet.
